About AlekSIS, schul-frei, and Teckids e.V.

About AlekSIS

- School Information System
- Web-based (Django, Material Design, PWA)
- App framework for extensions
- Entirely free software
(European Union Public Licence 1.2+)
- Developed by software engineers, students, and teachers

The schul-frei project

- Curates high-quality FOSS for education
 - Usability for particular purposes
 - Good integration
 - Good support
- Advises schools on establishing FOSS ecosystems
- Helps young people to get started as FOSS contributors

Teckids e.V.

- The Free Software youth organisation
- Founded in 2013 in Germany
- Emphasis on youth participation in the digital world
- Apart from schul-frei: Coding/tinkering summer camps; pedagogic concepts based on free, open, digital tools

Basics of an SIS

- Managing and providing information and data
- Class/course lists, plans, organisation,...
- Strictly not: anything non-organisational
 - Video conferencing, online courses,...

Structure of AlekSIS

- AlekSIS Core
- Official apps
 - Supported and shipped with default distribution
- Onboarding apps
 - Being brought in line with official apps
- Unofficial / third-party apps

AlekSIS Core

- Managing persons and groups
 - Students, teachers, classes, courses,...
- Basic information about school
- Dashboard
- Preferences
- Authentication
- Utilities for app development
 - Permissions, database model utilities, base templates,...

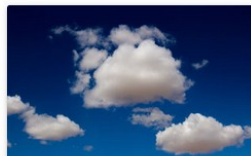

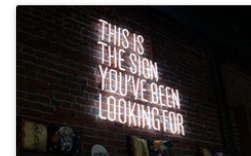

Integrations

- LDAP
 - Authentication and import of personal information
- Untis
 - Import timetables and substitutions
- CSV
 - Import personal information from CSV-like data

Furthermore...

- PDF generation
 - Manually and scheduled, e.g. for digital signage
- FAQ/support system
- Time-based documents
 - Weekly meal plans under stable URLs

Roadmap for 2022.6 «Cohn»

Integration with Matrix/Element

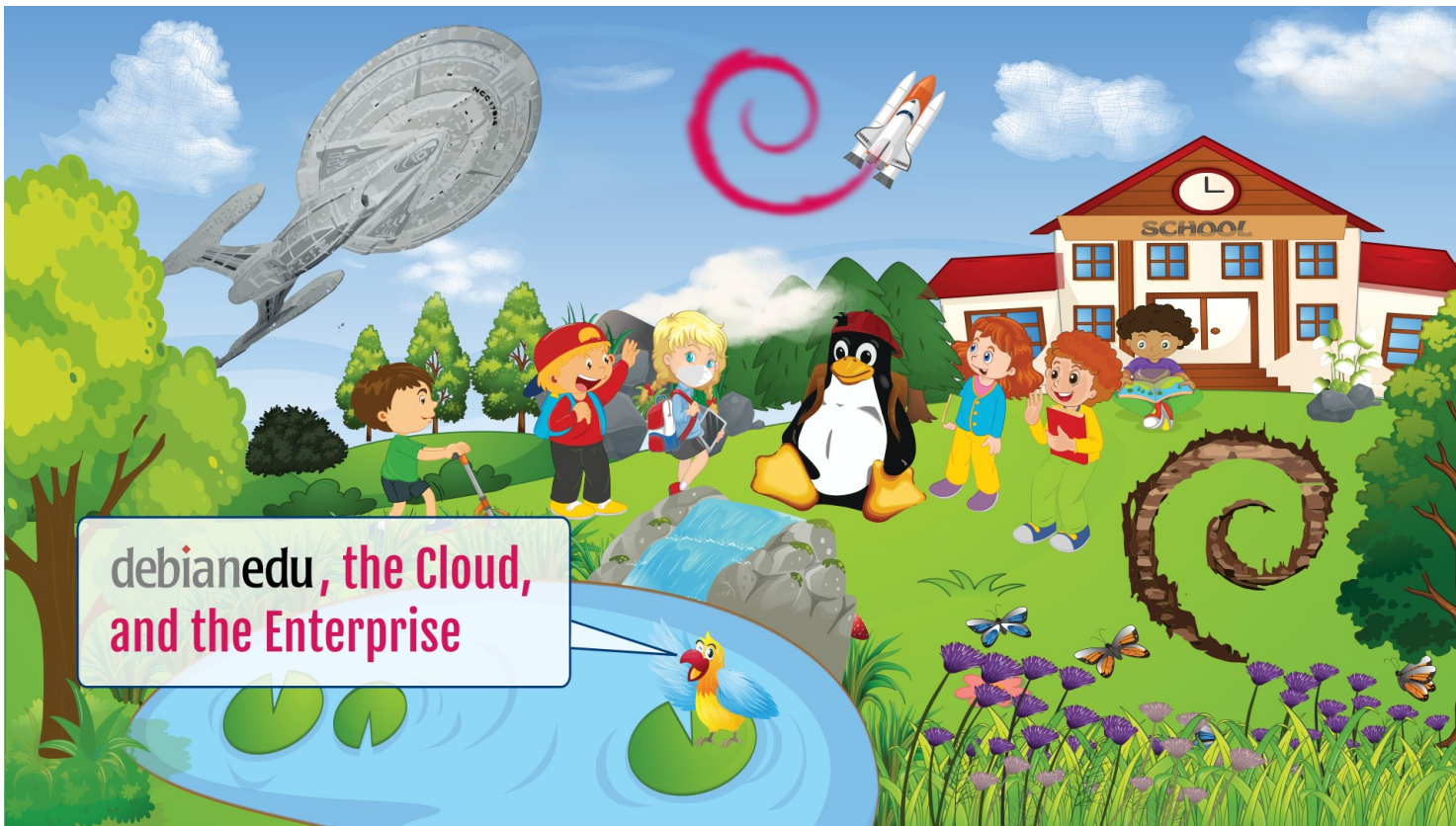
- Manage spaces and rooms for group structures in AlekSIS
- Maintain participants and moderators of rooms
- General idea:
 - Import classes, courses, students from your school management software
 - Get AlekSIS+Element+whatever synced immediately

Kort: Student ID cards, RFID

- Creation and registration of RFID cards in AlekSIS
- Printing of student ID cards (with and without RFID)
- API for systems using cards for authentication

Kompjuter: Debian Edu integration

- Manage desktops, tablets, laptops
- Manage software and configuration
- Make Debian Edu cloud-/SaaS-friendly
- Side projects:
 - Generic FAI Web API backend
 - Generic NSS/PAM Web API client



Design and development principles

Stable and secure software solution

- Tandem development (developer+maintainer)
 - Mandatory reviews
- Emphasis on stability
- Growing and improving test suite
- Helping schools enable privacy

Fostering junior development

- Extensible/modular codebase
- Development handbook
- Django text-book example
- Learn coding by digitising something relevant in your school!

Working with partner schools

Collecting knowledge from the field

- Every school is different
- Developers have few or no practical experience
- Students, teachers and parents know best how they want to work

Making FOSS visible

- Free Software is all about participation
- Licenses and all that are subordinate for most teachers and students
- Practical participation and individual digitisation is the most important feature of FOSS!

Digital education using AlekSIS

Coding clubs/classes

- Python is a good programming language for learning
- Students can be encouraged by developing something that will actually be used
- Digitise your school as a team!

Term papers

- Develop an AlekSIS app as practical work in a term paper
- Contains many relevant topics from German informatics curriculum
- Term papers become more than throw-away work

How to join

Non-German schools

- We need experience from school systems outside Germany. This means:
 - Schools open towards FOSS
 - Staff open towards participating in a project (with the reward of a cool school platform)
 - Multipliers with some free time for communication between AlekSIS and schools
 - Developers open for a new codebase and working with schools

Fostering companies

- Companies who want to donate money or development time
 - With the reward of being able to later provide commercial support for schools
- Donations to Teckids to foster young developers
