

Why we decided to use Grav

2018: migrate to Grav CMS from Confluence

- Avoid having to pay a fee per user
- Unify the CMSs used internally and externally
- Have control over the look and feel
- Customize according to users' needs



- Easy automation of generating and linting
- Multiple versions available at the same time
- Collaboration, easy contribution and reviewing
- Extensibility to support our needs
- Staged deployment and testing
- Distribution and performance
