



One binary, several graphical modes

- ▶ uniform *look and feel*



keys are assigned to language elements



- ▶ `+ magnify`
- ▶ `- reduce '20%'`
- ▶ `Del list 'pop';reload`
- ▶ `PageDown if(_display_console==0){next;}else{scd;}`
- ▶ ...

commands “reside” in CLI mode



- ▶ enter CLI mode with `:` (like in VIM)
- ▶ `Tab` autocomplete

- ▶ `[: -10% scale '-10%' reduce`
- ▶ `[: 3 goto 3`


- ▶ metadata (category) stored in a description file

Custom conversion pipelines



- ▶ filter each image file data

```
fim --pread-cmd="convert {} -charcoal 5 -pointsize 36 label:'{} charcoal' -append ppm:-" *
```



- ▶ like `find -exec 'cmd {}';'`

Fallback conversion pipelines



- ▶ on selected extensions (**SVG**, ..., DIA, XCF, ...)
- ▶ call external converter (**inkscape**, **convert**, ...)








